In this Privacy Policy the terms “we”, “us” and “our” are a reference to Irrigation Australia Limited.

1. About this Privacy Policy

Irrigation Australia is committed to the protection of your privacy and we want you to understand the terms and conditions surrounding the capture and use of any personal information we gather.

This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, how we use it, and your rights in relation to it.

2. Collection

We may gather two types of information about you:
